

Annex 2 – Labeling Specification Sheet (Rev. 1)

for the packaging of non-impregnated barbecue charcoal and barbecue charcoal briquettes according to DIN EN 1860-2

The packaging must be clearly labelled with (at least) the following information in the official language of the targeted market country:

1. Name and contact option of the manufacturer or the retailer/distributor.
(When having more than a single production facility, a clear distinction has to be established. For instance, you can choose a number, or one / several letter(s). DIN CERTCO must be informed of this labeling method).
2. Indication of the product: “barbecue charcoal” or “barbecue charcoal briquettes”;
3. Content as mass (kg) or volume (l);
4. Reference to the latest DIN standard and date of issue: DIN EN 1860-2:2023-08
5. The following warning notes:

“WARNING:

- Do not use in enclosed spaces;
- Keep children at a safe distance;
- Do not use additional firelighters after igniting the barbecue.”

Optional addition exclusively for commercial use:

- “For commercial use, barbecuing indoors requires a smoke extraction system.”

6. One of the graphical symbols according to Figure 1 a), Figure 1 b), or Figure 1 c) from Section 7.2.2 of DIN EN 1860-2:2023-08. (The graphical symbols must be represented in their original color composition and may only be altered in size proportionally)
7. The year of manufacture (or provision of a written confirmation sent to DIN CERTCO that this information will be printed during production); batch number if applicable;
8. Certification mark „DIN-Geprüft“ or „DINplus“ and registration number. (assigned by DIN CERTCO);

(Barbecue charcoal and barbecue charcoal briquettes in impregnated form or as bundled units must be labelled with additional consumer information. Information about this can be obtained from DIN CERTCO.)
