



EXPORTING TO THE EURASIAN ECONOMIC UNION REQUIREMENTS FOR TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

Along with the establishment of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) in 2014, 35 technical regulations have so far been adopted. They resolve the existing national requirements and have been applied uniformly in all member states of the Economic Union - Russia, Belarus, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan and Armenia - since then.

Technical regulations have also been adopted for the industrial sector which must be considered when exporting your machinery, equipment, and devices. The binding safety requirements refer to the design, manufacture and assembly as well as the commissioning and labeling of the goods to be exported.

Equipment may be placed on the market of the EAEU only if they comply with the requirements of one or more technical regulations (TR) of the Customs Union and have undergone a mandatory procedure for the conformity assessment or certification according to these regulations. Once conformity with the requirements has been established, the goods are labelled with the Eurasian Conformity (EAC) mark of compliance before being placed on the market.

TR ZU 004/2011	On Low-Voltage Equipment Safety (in force since 01 July 2012)
TR ZU 010/2011	On safety of machinery and equipment (in force since 15 February 2013)
TR ZU 012/2011	On safety of the equipment for operation in explosive atmospheres (in force since 15 February 2013)
TR ZU 016/2011	On safety of devices operating on the gaseous fuel (in force since 15 February 2013)
TR ZU 020/2011	Hardware electromagnetic compatibility (in force since 15 February 2013)
TR ZU 032/2013	On safety of pressure vessels (in force since 01 February 2014)
